



# Level 3 Certificate in Supporting Teaching & Learning in Schools



## Who is this course suitable for?

This qualification is suitable for individuals who directly support the teaching and learning of pupils within a school setting. This includes Teaching Assistants, Learning Support Assistants etc, from all types of schools.

The qualification is a combination of knowledge and competency based units to ensure a true reflection of those supporting pupils' learning.



## Course Content

This qualification consists of **32** credits, made up of **11** units. All units must be completed in order to achieve the full qualification although single unit accreditation is available.

### Units:

- Communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults (Credit value: 2)
- Schools as organisations (Credit value: 3)
- Support learning activities (Credit value: 4)
- Promote children and young people's positive behaviour (Credit value: 3)
- Develop professional relationships with children, young people and adults (Credit value: 2)
- Promote equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people (Credit value: 2)
- Support assessment for learning (Credit value: 4)
- Understand child and young

person development (Credit value: 4)

- Engage in personal development in health, social care or children's and young people's settings (Credit value: 3)
- Understand how to safeguard the well being of children and young people (Credit value: 3)
- Support children and young people's health and safety (Credit value: 2)

## Why do this course?

On completion of this course you will receive a nationally recognised qualification, accredited by City and Guilds, which proves you have attained a level of job competence.

## Delivery

This qualification is available through 2 delivery methods.

## Delivery Option 1- Distance Learning

You will be allocated an assessor who will provide you with

guidance via phone and email to build a portfolio of evidence in line with the qualification standard. You will also be given access to our online qualification portal which provides access to resources and assignments.

The evidence you will need to produce will include completing assignments, writing personal statements and undertaking professional discussions with your assessor. You may also need to get a witness testimony from a senior colleague at your school to confirm your performance of certain tasks in line with the qualification standard.

## **Delivery Option 2 – Enhanced Distance Learning/Work Based Learning**

This option is available to individuals who work within the Yorkshire region. We may also be able to deliver in this way to those who work in other areas for a minimum cohort of 10 candidates.

The qualification will be delivered through a combination of distance learning and work

based learning. You will be allocated an assessor who will provide you with guidance via phone and email to build a portfolio of evidence in line with the qualification standard. In addition you will also receive 3 face to face support visits on the schools premises. You will also be given access to our online qualification portal which provides access to resources and assignments.

The evidence you will need to produce will include completing assignments, writing personal statements and undertaking professional discussions with your assessor. You may also need to get a witness testimony from a senior colleague at your school to confirm your performance of certain tasks in line with the qualification standard.

## **Course Duration**

An average time of completion is around 10 months for this course, however you can complete sooner if you wish. We will discuss this with you at enrolment. You can start this course at any time.

## **Entry Requirements**

To undertake this course you must already be working in a school in a role which supports classroom/learning activities. You will need to have access to a computer, the internet and be able to use Microsoft Word and email.

## **Cost**

The cost for this qualification is £675 for the Distance Learning route and £900 for the Enhanced Distance Learning route. You can pay in 3 instalments.

The price is fully inclusive of all costs including registration and certification from City and Guilds, tutor support and learning materials, including a text book for the qualification by Louise Burnham.
