



Level 2 Certificate in Supporting the Wider Curriculum in Schools



Who is this course suitable for?

This qualification is ideally suited to those working as midday assistants/supervisors or who support the wider activities of the school such as before and after school clubs. It has a wide variety of units to choose from, acknowledging that many teaching assistants also undertake midday duties.



Course Content

The qualification is made up of units, which each have a credit value. You must achieve a minimum of **20** credits to gain the full qualification. There are **6** mandatory units; you must then select a minimum of **6** credits from the optional units, **3** from Optional Group A and **3** from Optional Group B. All units must be completed in order to achieve the full qualification although single unit accreditation is available.

Mandatory Units (14 credits):

- Child and young person development (Credit value: 2)
- Safeguarding the welfare of children and young people (Credit value: 3)
- Communication and professional relationships with children, young people and adults (Credit value: 2)
- Equality, diversity and inclusion in work with children and young people (Credit value: 2)

- Support children and young people's health and safety (Credit value: 3)
- Support children and young people's positive behaviour (Credit value: 2)

Optional Units (Minimum of 6 credits):

Group A (Minimum of 3 credits)

- Schools as organisations - Level 2 (Credit value: 3)
- Schools as organisations - Level 3 (Credit value: 3)

Group B (Minimum of 3 credits)

- Maintain and support relationships with children and young people (Credit value: 3)
- Support children and young people at meal or snack times (Credit value: 3)
- Support children and young people's play and leisure (Credit value: 3)
- Support children and young people's travel outside of the setting (Credit value: 3)
- Support extra-curricular activities (Credit value: 3)

Why do this course?

On completion of this course you will receive a nationally recognised qualification, accredited by City and Guilds, which proves you have attained a level of job competence.

Delivery

This qualification is available through 2 delivery methods.

Delivery Option 1- Distance Learning

You will be allocated an assessor who will provide you with guidance via phone and email to build a portfolio of evidence in line with the qualification standard. You will also be given access to our online qualification portal which provides access to resources and assignments.

The evidence you will need to produce will include completing assignments, writing personal statements and undertaking professional discussions with your assessor. You may also need to get a witness testimony from a senior colleague at your school to

confirm your performance of certain tasks in line with the qualification standard.

Delivery Option 2 - Enhanced Distance Learning/Work Based Learning

This option is available to individuals who work within the Yorkshire region. We may also be able to deliver in this way to those who work in other areas for a minimum cohort of 10 candidates.

The qualification will be delivered through a combination of distance learning and work based learning. You will be allocated an assessor who will provide you with guidance via phone and email to build a portfolio of evidence in line with the qualification standard. In addition you will also receive 3 face to face support visits on the schools premises. You will also be given access to our online qualification portal which provides access to resources and assignments.

The evidence you will need to produce will include completing



assignments, writing personal statements and undertaking professional discussions with your assessor. You may also need to get a witness testimony from a senior colleague at your school to confirm your performance of certain tasks in line with the qualification standard.

Course Duration

An average time of completion is around 9 months for this course, however you can complete sooner if you wish. We will discuss this with you at enrolment. You can start this course at any time.
